- Ans:-
1. Aadhaar card → It is issued by the Unique Identification Authority of India. It has 12 digit number which serves as a proof of identity and address, anywhere in India.
  2. The Voter ID card → It is issued by the Election Commission of India. Its main purpose is the proof of identity while casting votes during general elections.
  3. PAN → Permanent Account Number [PAN] is a ten-digit alphanumeric number, issued in form of a laminated card by Income Tax Department to link all financial transactions of a person with the department.
  4. Debit card → It is issued by a bank that allows the holder to transfer money electronically from bank account, when making a purchase, also used to withdraw cash from an ATM and purchase goods and services at point of sale/E-commerce.
  5. Credit card → It is used by bank to the user as a method of payment also allows the holder to pay for goods.
