Q1:- How many ^{major} types of questions are describe in English grammar

Ans:- English grammar describes three major types of questions:

1. **Yes-no questions:** The reply to these questions is *yes* or *no*.

eg:- 1. Have you had lunch?

2. Is there a lizard in the kitchen?

3. Will she go out this evening?

2. **Wh-questions:** These questions are formed using question words like *what*, *why*, *when*, *who*, *where* and *how*.

The reply to them is not a simple *yes* or *no*, but one from an open range of responses.

eg:- 1. QUESTION: Where is Nitya's house?

ANSWER: It's in Lalbagh.

2. QUESTION: Why can't you write down the instructions?

ANSWER: Because I don't have time.

3. QUESTION: How do you open this?

ANSWER: By turning the knob in the anti-clockwise direction.)

3. **Alternative questions:** The reply to alternative questions is one of the options given by the question itself.

eg: 1. Would you like to watch TV or chat online?

2. Is her name Ashwini or Anusha?

3. Will he sing a song or do a magic trick?

2. QUESTION: who opened the door last night when you came back?

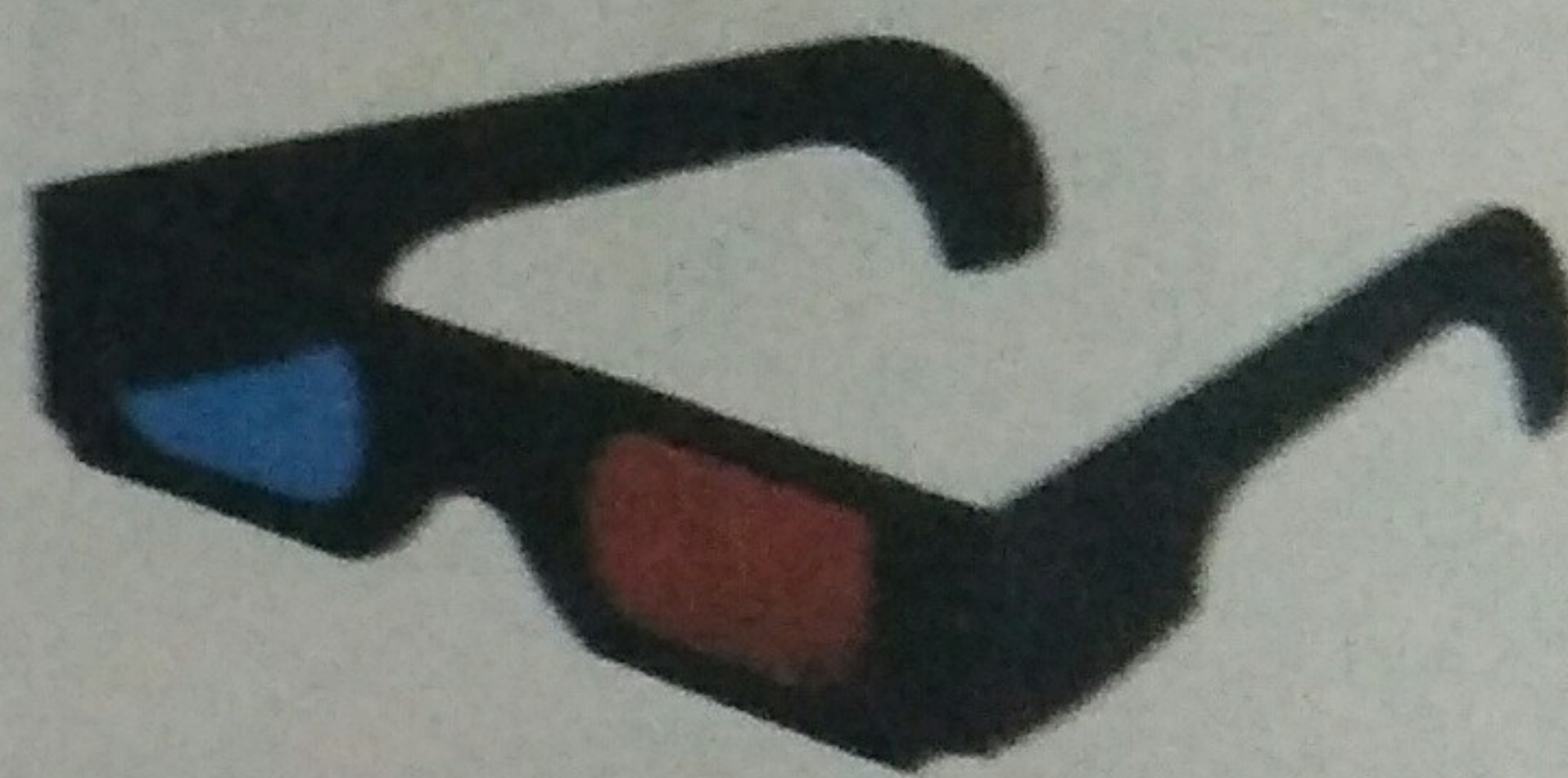
ANSWER: It was uncle Prasad.
