What are the four types of sentences?

The four types of sentences are declarative, exclamatory, imperative and interrogative.

Explanation:-

Declarative sentences:- tell something and end with a full stop.
eg:- Amazon is a river.

Interrogative sentences:- asks a question and ends with a question mark.
eg:- who left the fridge open?

Imperative sentences:- give a command or an advice, or make a request.
eg:- Let's go home.

Exclamatory sentences:- show strong feelings and end with an exclamation mark.

eg:- what a fine necklace Saroj has!
